Mano Sotelo Supply List:

**Supply List:**

- 18 x 24 White paper / Drawing or Sketch pad (any brand will work – I use Strathmore)
- Wooden sketch pad board (to place behind your drawing pad)
- Charcoal pencils (HB, 2B and 4B or hard, medium and soft) - General or Prang are the most popular brands - \* “Peel and wrap” are easier to sharpen)
- Soft vine charcoal
- Gum eraser
- Tuff stuff erasure stick
- Utility knife to sharpen charcoal pencils (You will NOT need this if you use “peel and wrap” charcoal pencils)
- Sandpaper block (for sharpening charcoal)
- Blending paper stump

OPTIONAL

- Soft brush to wipe away erasure residue from drawing (I use a make up brush)
- Old bristle brush for blending
- Graphite may be used as a substitute for charcoal, however, make sure you bring a range of pencils (2H, HB, 2B, 6B) and a sharpener
- Pastel pencils can be used as a substitute, if preferred.
- 18 x 24 sketch pad is recommended; however, a smaller size can be used as a substitute.
- Mahl stick, or wooden dowel to stabilize hand while drawing. I use a green garden stick.
