

Pastel Workshop Supply List - Nancy Nowak

Soft Pastels a mixture of hard and soft pastels, the more the better (Schmincke, Unison, Great American, Terry Ludwig, NuPastel, Sennelier, Blue Earth etc.)

Tray or plate for your pastel palette

Sanded Paper: Sanded Paper: 9 x 12 or 11 x 14 of UART 400 or Lux Pastel paper(2 sheets per day). Mounted and not tinted preferred. We will be painting with wet under paintings (alcohol wash and watercolor) and some other types of sanded papers are not conducive for this particular workshop (for example: Sennelier La Carte)

Backboard: piece of foam core

Reference Photos of landscapes: have a bunch to choose from

If you have an iPad or laptop, please bring with your photos uploaded

Also have printed (paper) photos off your computer. We will probably be cropping elements from your photo, so please print it large enough so you can see details (at least 8 1/2 x 11).

small sketch pad

pen to take notes

pencil and kneaded eraser

masking tape

Isopropyl rubbing alcohol 70% (and separate jar)

a few stiff **paint brushes** (1/2 " or 3/4 " flat)

Viva Paper towels

hand wipes (optional)

latex gloves (optional)

Watercolor set (can be an inexpensive set - or at least a tube of a red, yellow, and blue) **Pallet for mixing and water container**

Easel if not supplied

Hint: Unify your pastels in one box for ease of use. Sort by color and value
